

THE JIGSAW OF HOMELESS SUPPORT

People who have experienced homelessness face challenges that are not just about housing. They can suffer chronic social isolation, poor physical and mental health and lack of autonomy. The arts can build well-being, strengthen social networks, challenge public perceptions and enable people's voice to be heard. Homelessness support tends to be hierarchical with most urgent, practical needs coming first. In reality, people with multiple needs require multiple solutions right from the outset, where they can choose from a jigsaw of options.
